

AWANA Achievement Rewards

As clubbers work through their books each week they can receive different completion awards throughout the year. If they complete their books they could potentially receive ribbons, pins, plaques or trophies, and other surprises depending on how hard the kids work and what level they complete.

Important Information


Cost - There are some small costs involved for kids in AWANA.

AWANA stands for ‘Approved Workmen Are Not Ashamed.’ It is a Biblically based Christian children’s ministry that has operated for over 60 years in thousands of churches in over 100 countries around the world. The weekly AWANA program is made up of five distinct age groups: Cubbies, Sparks, Truth and Training (T&T), Trek and Journey 24/7. Cubbies, Sparks and T&T offer games, crafts, Bible Lessons, and loads of surprises each week. In addition, each child is encouraged to wear a uniform and do weekly Bible work from their corresponding handbooks where they will be rewarded for their achievements. At AWANA, kids will have loads of fun and learn about God at the same time.

The Cubbies program is designed for children ages 3 (as of Dec. 31 of the current year) & 4. Their time is spent with stories, puppets, games, crafts, and a snack. For this age group all the Cubbies move through the handbook at the same pace, memorizing scripture verses at home and reciting to leaders during club time.



Sparks is similar to Cubbies, but is designed for kids ages 5 to 8 (SK - Grade 2). At this level the children are encouraged to complete their workbooks at home and then say their verses at club time, as well as having their very own council (Bible lesson) time.



Truth & Training (T&T) is especially designed for the older kids, ages 8 to 12 (grade 3 - grade 6), with similar activities already described. T&T is separated into 4 distinct groups: Chums, is for girls grades 3 & 4; Pals, is for boys grades 3 & 4; Guards, is for girls grades 5 & 6; and Pioneers, is for boys grades 5 & 6.



Finally, there is additional work that can be done through AWANA specifically designed for Jr. High and Sr. High students. Trek, is for the Jr. Highs & Journey 24/7 is for the Sr. highs.
