**Cost** - There are some small costs involved for kids in AWANA.

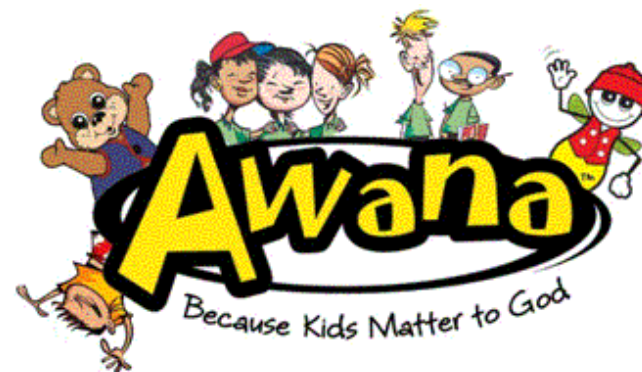
Registration Fee	= \$20.00

AWANA stands for 'Approved Workmen Are Not Ashamed.' It is a Biblically based Christian children's ministry that has operated for over 60 years in thousands of churches in over 100 countries around the world. The weekly AWANA program is made up of Cubbies, Sparks, & Truth and Training (T&T). **Cubbies**, **Sparks** and **T&T** offer games, crafts, Bible Lessons, and loads of surprises each week. In addition, each child is encouraged to wear a uniform and do weekly Bible work from their corresponding handbooks. At AWANA, kids will have loads of fun and learn about God at the same time.

**Sparks** is similar to Cubbies, but is designed for kids ages 5 to 8 (SK - Grade 2). At this level the children will spend time with their leaders in groups as they memorize Bible verses and understand its meaning. Children are always encouraged to look ahead to the following week's lesson and prepare for the next week. Songs, games, crafts, council time, and snack are all part of this fun **Sparks** program.



**Truth & Training (T&T)** is especially designed for the older kids, Grade 3 - Grade 6, with similar activities already described. **T&T** is separated into groups: Grades 3 & 4 and Grades 5 & 6.



Finally, there is additional work that can be done through AWANA, specifically designed for Jr. High and Sr. High students. **Trek** is for the Jr. Highs & Journey 24/7 is for the Sr. High students.
